- 1.3 The Chair provided an update on recent Assembly activity, including: the Budget and Performance Committee's scrutiny of the Mayor's 2024-25 budget, including funding proposals for the London Fire Brigade, the Mayor's Office for Policing and Crime, and the Metropolitan Police Service, and direct questions to the Mayor of London; the Police and Crime Committee's discussion on money laundering in London; the examination of Transport for London's tree planting programme and land controlled by the Greater London Authority (GLA) by the Environment Committee; the Economy Committee's meeting on the impact of Brexit on London's economy; the publication of the Economy Committee's report on childcare in London; the Housing Committee's review of the state of the Build to Rent sector in London; and the GLA Oversight Committee's discussion on the performance of the London Pensions Fund Authority.
- 1.4 The Chair concluded his announcements by congratulating all Londoners and GLA family colleagues who had received awards in the King's New Year's Honours List.
