- 6.4 During the course of the discussion the Director of Licensing and Regulation, TfL, agreed to provide the following:
 - TfL's policy paper on cross border licensing and hiring issues;
 - Confirmation that issues around spare parts and repairs to London Electric Vehicle Company (LEVC) cabs would be raised in TfL's next discussion with LEVC;
 - Detail on the internal organisation of the licensing function within TfL, who they report to, who holds them to account, and what legislation governs them;
 - A written response to points raised by the General Secretary, LTDA, on letters sent to LTDA members on their fitness to be licensed following issues with 20 mile-per-hour speed limits; and
 - Copies of sample warning letters sent to taxi drivers by TfL.
- 6.5 During the course of the discussion, the General Secretary, LTDA, agreed to provide a copy of the letter from TfL sent to a LTDA member, which was referenced at the meeting, regarding the driver's fitness to be licensed.
