- 2. The data is derived from BTP recorded crime data from April-2018 to November-23 inclusive.
- 3. The determination of line is derived from a field within the data provided to TfL which indicates which line the incident occurred on. There is a further field to determine if the offence took place on the train, within the station premises or lineside. For the purpose of this request, the data provided only takes account of 'on train' crimes. Where a line was not recorded, this is marked in the bottom table "Line Not Recorded".
- 4. The 'crime groups' include a number of sub-categories. A further tab has been included which shows the association between sub-category and combined crime type see tab 'Crime Group Mapping' below. This grouping is consistent with how crime data will be displayed on the public transport crime dashboard that TfL aim to release later this year.
- 5. Please note that TfL receive crime data monthly in arrears from the BTP. As crime data is dynamic in nature (e.g., some crimes may be found to be "no-crimes" or may change crime type during the course of an investigation), the figures displayed in this document are subject to change especially recent records.
