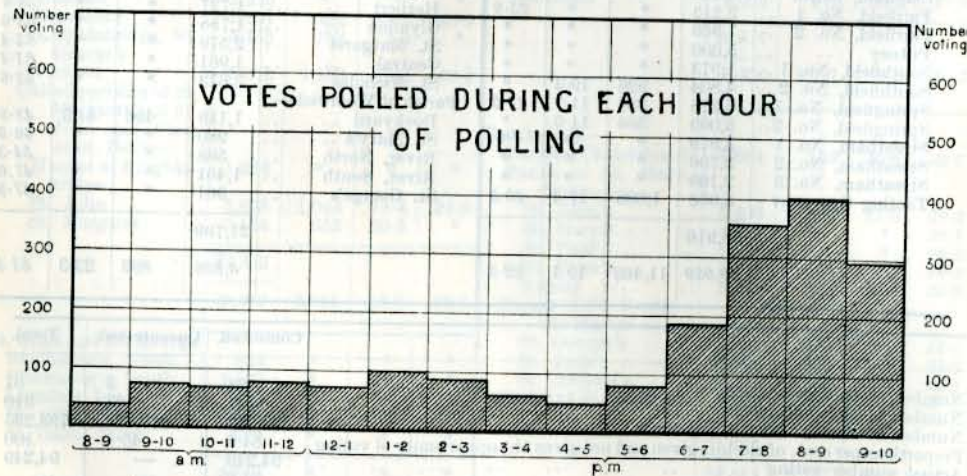

At the last parliamentary general election, the whole electorate (100 per cent.) was given the opportunity of voting; at the last county council election 100 per cent.; at the last borough elections, 90.9 per cent.; at the last guardians' elections, 54.6 per cent.
