

# Subject: Action Taken by the Chairman under Delegated Authority

## 1. Summary

- 1.1 This report outlines recent action taken by the Chairman in accordance with the general delegations granted to him under the Authority's Standing Orders, namely to invite the Mayor and the Deputy Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis to the Assembly (Plenary) meeting on 9 December 2014.

## 2. Recommendation

- 2.1 **That the Assembly notes the recent action taken by the Chairman of the Assembly, Roger Evans AM, under the GLA's Standing Order 10.2A(1), namely to invite the Mayor and the Deputy Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis to the Assembly (Plenary) meeting on 9 December 2014.**

## 3. Background

- 3.1 Due to conflicting diary commitments and following consultation with the Mayor's Office, the Metropolitan Police Commissioner's Office and the Assembly's party Group Leaders, the Chairman announced at July's Assembly (Plenary) meeting that the date of the Plenary meeting in December had been provisionally moved from 3 December to 9 December at 3pm in order to discuss policing in London. All Groups confirmed that they were content with those proposals.

## 4. Issues for Consideration

- 4.1 Following consultation with party Group Leaders about the December 2014 Plenary meeting, the Chairman wrote to invite the Mayor and the Deputy Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis to the Assembly (Plenary) meeting on 9 December 2014 to discuss policing in London. Both letters are attached as **Appendix 1** and **Appendix 2**.
