

Response to follow up request for information from the 10 November 2020 meeting of the Housing Committee – COVID-19, Rough Sleeping and Homelessness in London

Request for information:

During the course of the discussion Members, requested that the Rough Sleeping Lead, GLA, provide the following information:

- Data on the schemes being funded under the Rough Sleeping Accommodation Programme (RSAP), including the types of homes and tenancies, and an estimate of the revenue and capital amount needed per home under each scheme;
- A breakdown of the approximately £65 million rough sleeping budget including the source of the funding and what it is allocated to; and

Response:

Details for the RSAP question below – with regards to the budget we have recently been successful in obtaining more money for government to support with SWEP so just adding this to the response.

The Mayor has secured £93.4m from Government to deliver over 900 longer-term homes and support for homeless Londoners. Funding allocations for 2020/21 were announced in October 2020 and can be found [here](#). 38 projects were successful with a range of delivery approaches including acquisition, remodelling or refurbishment, new build, and modular. Most homes will be self-contained flats with fixed term shorthold tenancies or similar.
