## Housing Standards MALP - RESPONSE TO CONSULTATION

Regarding the Housing Standards Minor Alterations, I am concerned that the rules for accessibility and Lifetime Homes will now only apply to new homes, and not to renovations and extensions. If building regulations are a barrier to extending the policies in this way, the Mayor should lobby for minor changes to accommodate that.

I am also concerned that Lifetime Homes won't be required for buildings of four stories or fewer, only Part M standards. Again, I recognise that there are legal issues with going further, but if this resulted in fewer homes being built to a standard that ensures they are fully accessible to people with disabilities, that would be hugely disappointing.
