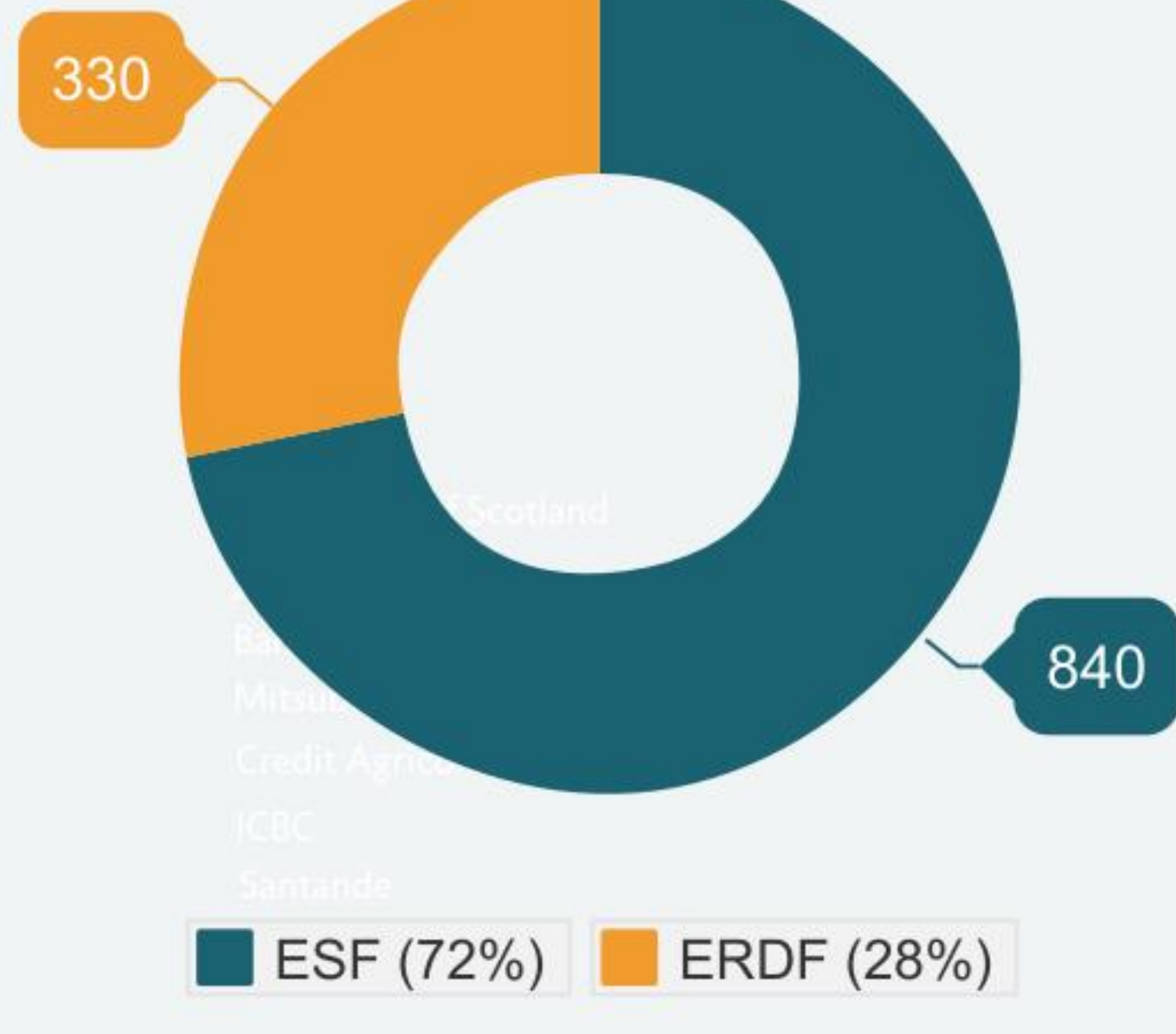


European Structural Funds
