Dear *Dr Sahota,*

Thank you for your letter of 3 March to the Secretary of State about the ULEZ scrappage scheme funding. I am replying as the Minister for Roads and Local Transport.

As you are aware, responsibility for air quality in London is devolved. It would be for the Mayor of London and the GLA to budget for any funding the impact clean air initiatives have on drivers and businesses inside and on the boundary with London.

London has received almost £102m of Government funding for projects specifically targeted at helping to tackle pollution. Through the longer-term funding settlement, Government has committed over £6 billion to secure the long-term future of London's transport network, keeping public transport moving so people have low-emission alternatives to get around the capital, while driving down congestion.
