
## Crime in England and Wales: year ending September 2022 NOTES

**The ONS Report states** - "Patterns of crime over recent years have been substantially affected by the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic and government restrictions on social contact. "

"Police recorded crime in England and Wales in the year ending September 2022 exceeded pre-coronovirus pandemic levels. The 6.6 million crimes recorded were 10% higher compared with the year ending March 2020 (6.1 million offences). This overall increase was largely driven by increases in the offence categories, which are most subject to changes in reporting and recording practices. Therefore, these estimates should be treated with caution as they may not reflect a genuine increase in crime."

#### **Total Recorded Crime (excluding fraud)**




For the 12-month period ending September 2022 the MPS recorded 862,065 offences - an increase of **+12.1%** as compared to the previous year.

England and Wales (excl. MPS) increased by +12.6%, with the Most Similar Group also recording an increase of 14.6%.


The MPS had the 11th highest rate of offending in England and Wales for total recorded crime (excluding fraud) at **95.9 offences per 1,000 population** (weighted by mid-year 2020 population).

#### **Victim Based Crime**




Victim Based Crimes **increased** in the twelve months to September 2022 compared to the previous year **(+14.4%)**.

Victim Based Crimes **increased by +14%** across the rest of England and Wales whilst there was a **+15.5% increase in the Most Similar Group**.




Violence against the person offences increased **(+6.9%)**. The rest of England and Wales **increased by +11.4%** and the MSG recorded a **+11.8% increase**.


Violence with injury **(+12.8%)** also **increased**. However, Stalking and Harassment reduced slightly in the MPS **(-5.0%)**, with increases across England and Wales.



Recorded sexual offences **increased by 17.5%**, compared to **+16.6%** for the rest of England and Wales and **+9.8%** for the MSG.




There was a **+16.1%** increase in Robbery in the MPS. The rest of England and Wales also **increased (+14.7%)** and the MSG recorded a **+12.7%** increase.




Total Theft Offences **increased by +20.9%**, while the rest of England and Wales increased by **+20%** and the MSG by **+23.0%**.

Theft from the Person increased significantly (+65.1%), whilst residential burglary reduced (-7%).




Criminal Damage and Arson increased **(4.9%)**. The rest of England and Wales also recorded an increase **(9.3%)** as did the MSG **(+14.1%)**.



Other Crimes Against Society remained relatively unchanged **(+0.2%)**. The rest of England and Wales recorded an increase **(+6.2%)** as did the MSG **(+10.6%)**.



In the year to September 2022 there was an increase of **+10.5%** in knife crime. This is compared to an **+10.6%** increase across the rest of England and Wales and **+16.1%** in the MSG.



In the year to September 2022 there was a reduction of **-4.2%** in firearm offences. The rest of England and Wales and MSG both recorded increases.
