THE GLA SIDE ROADS (LONDON BOROUGH OF LEWISHAM) DESIGNATION ORDER 2007 VARIATION ORDER 2023

Made	31 July 2023
Coming into force	31 July 2023

The Mayor of London considers it expedient that certain roads in the London Borough of Lewisham should become or cease to be GLA Side Roads. Therefore, the Greater London Authority, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 124B(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984¹ and of all other enabling powers, and with the consent of the Council of the London Borough of Lewisham, hereby makes the following Order:

1. Citation and Commencement

This Order may be cited as The GLA Side Roads (London Borough of Lewisham) Designation Order 2007 Variation Order 2023 and shall come into force on February 2023.

2. Variation

From the date on which this Order comes into force, the schedule to The GLA Side Roads (London Borough of Lewisham) Designation Order 2007, is varied as follows:

In the Schedule items 2228 is amended
