The provisions of section 43(2) provide that information can constitute exempt information if its disclosure would, or would be likely to, be prejudicial to the commercial activities of any party.

In this case, disclosure of this information into the public domain would prejudice the legitimate commercial interest of Babcock Training Ltd, a key commercial partner of the London Fire Commissioner. The information herein is commercially sensitive in that its disclose would provide their competitors with information that would distort competition in the market in which it operates. Similarly, publication of this information would serve to prejudice the commercial interest of the London Fire Commissioner's ability to secure value for money on behalf of the public.
