## Repairs at Coniston House, Mile End Estate, Southern Grove, London E3 4SU

I am writing to you instead of contacting the Corporate Director of Housing and Regeneration, as I understand this role is currently being recruited for.

I have been contacted by a resident representing a group of neighbours who live in Coniston House, Mile End Estate. They have told me about the problems caused to their homes from building works by Eastend Homes, relating to the construction of a two-storey roof extension to Coniston House given permission under Planning Application PA/17/02373 in January 2020.

At the end of November 2023, the resident informed me:

"The damage to the roof affects me and 11 of my neighbours, but the building works have seriously disturbed everyone in the building.

"The demolition work on our roof to enable the construction has shattered our peace for months. However, two months ago, it became apparent that they had catastrophically compromised the roof, and all my neighbours and I have had water flooding into our homes for the past two months every time it rains.

"Our homes have been unable to dry, and mould is spreading everywhere.

"Winter is here, so we now have to choose between airing our homes or staying warm."

The residents have already sought support from Apsana Begum, MP for Poplar and Limehouse, and shared with me a copy of letter to her from Eastend Homes, dated 15 November 2023, outlining the remedial works being undertaken (attached).

Frustratingly for the residents, they contacted me again on 2 January 2024 to say that, despite Eastend Homes' promises to deal with the problems caused by the construction, they are still massively inconvenienced by the construction work, specifically: "Our roof has been leaking for over two months, and winter is here."

I would like to request that you ask Planning Enforcement Officers to urgently follow up with the affected residents in Coniston House to investigate the ongoing problems, ensure all planning conditions are being met, and urge Eastend Homes to take further action to make residents' homes habitable again.

I look forward to receiving a response from you.
