

## Transport for London (Penalty Fares) Order 2024

The Mayor of London in the exercise of the powers conferred by paragraphs 2(4) and 5(2) of Schedule 17 to the Greater London Authority Act 1999 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order.

## Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Transport for London (Penalty Fares) Order 2024.
2. This Order shall come into effect on 3 March 2024.

## Revocations

3. Upon this Order coming into effect, the Transport for London (Penalty Fares) Order 2011 shall be revoked.

### **Application of the Penalty fares provisions**

4. The penalty fares provisions defined in paragraph 1 of Schedule 17 to the Greater London Authority Act 1999 shall have effect with respect to all local services and train services to which Schedule 17 to the Greater London Authority Act 1999 applies, by virtue of paragraph 2(1) of that schedule.

## Penalty fare levels

5. This Order applies to all local services and train services to which Schedule 17 to the Greater London Authority Act 1999 applies, by virtue of paragraph 2(1) of that schedule.
6. The penalty fare in respect of any journey on any local service and any train service to which this Order applies shall from the date on which this order comes into effect, be:
  - (i) £100 except where (ii) below applies, or
  - (ii) £50 if it is paid before the end of the period of 21 days beginning with the day following the day on which the journey is completed

and shall in all cases be payable to the person providing the service on which the requirement to pay the relevant fare is made.

### Explanatory Note

This Order increases the penalty fare payable in relation to journeys on local services and trains services to which Schedule 17 of the Greater London Authority Act 1999 applies to £100 reduced to £50 if paid within 21 days. This Order has effect from 3 March 2024.
