
Background

Ridership is recovering, and we are now at 90 per cent of pre pandemic levels on all public transport services in London.

The recovery has been stronger at weekends, where leisure travel has bounced back and often exceeds prepandemic levels.

During the week the position varies by day of week, with ridership on Fridays having the greatest disparity with pre-pandemic ridership levels, particularly the morning peak.







Number of Journeys on TfL's Rail Modes between 6.30am and 9.30am (millions)
