Over the last two years, London's Violence Reduction Unit has invested in more than 150,000 positive opportunities.

Since the VRU was set up in 2019, the first of its kind in England, there has been a 22 per cent reduction in homicides, a 20 per cent fall in knife crime with injury for those aged under-25, and a 16 per cent reduction in robbery. [Compared to November 2018 when the set-up of the VRU was announced.]
