You can move around.

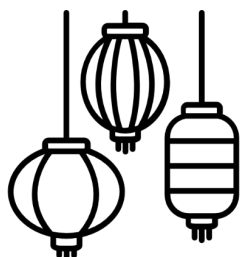
You do not need to be quiet.

	<p>Main Stage</p> <p>The main stage will have lots of exciting performances for everyone to enjoy throughout the day.</p> <p>There will be nasheeds, which are acapella or vocal based songs. There will be music, dancing, poetry and special shows.</p>

Transport Information

You can get to Trafalgar Square by bus and the nearest underground stations are Charing Cross and Leicester Square.

	<p>First Aid</p> <p>First Aid is located on the right side of the main stage at the information point.</p>
	<p>Safety</p> <p>There will be bag checks at the entry points for safety.</p>
	<p>Help at the Event</p> <p>Stewards and volunteers will be available to help.</p> <p>Information Desk: located on the right side of the main stage, for any questions or assistance.</p>
	<p>If there's an emergency your companion must help you get out, and a steward or a member of our team will also help.</p>
	<p>Bring dry and warm clothes in case it rains.</p>
	<p>If you bring a water bottle you can fill it up for free as often as you like.</p>
