

Introduction to Black On The Square

The Mayor of London's Black On The Square takes place at Trafalgar Square, in central London, on Friday 6 September 2024.

The event runs from 12pm to 6pm. There is no need to book a ticket, and entrance is free.

Black On The Square is a celebration of Black culture and creativity, open and accessible to all.

It brings people together through music, art, fashion, food, and community, and highlights the talent, heritage and stories of London's diverse Black communities.

The event includes:

- A main stage packed with live music, dance, and spoken word performances.
- Expect a vibrant mix of genres and talents, including established artists and rising stars.
- Art displays, fashion showcases, and live DJ sets across the square

You can also enjoy freestyle rap and interactive experiences.

Family-friendly activities, such as:

- Creative workshops
- Arts and crafts
- Children's face painting
- Community engagement stalls

A diverse food market and Black-owned stalls, offering:

Delicious cuisine from across the African and Caribbean diaspora, handmade gifts, books, crafts, homeware and more.
