A circular economy at Minerva Road – our first meanwhile use project!



Before turning our new site on Minerva Road into an energy centre in 2026, we're transforming it into a circular economy hub for the community, where local organisations will repurpose waste materials into new, useful and affordable products.

The building will be used to create workspace for local businesses and suppliers, including Remade x Re-collective, Absolute Beginners, Sweet Terrain and Rescued Clay, to create furniture, tableware and panelling using recycled materials like old TV and film sets and clay from major construction projects, like High Speed 2.

This follows some new and innovative research on Park Royal's circular economy, commissioned by OPDC and HS2. It was launched at the weekend with an exhibition on show until 22nd September at our new building on Minerva Road, as part of Park Royal Design District and London Design Festival! 




The event will return next year, so be sure not to miss it!

Funding Opportunity with Arts Council England



Arts Council England have opened their funding programme for the **National Portfolio Creative People and Place Funding for 2026 – 2029**.

The funding focuses on parts of the country where involvement in creativity and culture is significantly below the national average. It supports partners in local areas to work with residents on what creative activity they want to see on their doorstep.

You can apply for funding from £750,000 - £1,000,000 for a three-year term for projects based in eligible areas which includes Brent and Ealing.

Applications close on Thursday 16th January 2025.
