

Yinka Ilori inspires the next generation of West **London artists**



Yinka Ilori MBE is a celebrated British-Nigerian multidisciplinary artist and designer. He has built a reputation for creating works that tell vivid, uplifting stories, focusing on themes of community, joy, and affirmation.

His signature use of bold colours and engaging narratives is widely recognised, with each project designed to connect and inspire people in meaningful ways.



Yinka's studio is based at EX2 in Park Royal and he's teaming up with BUILDHOLLYWOOD and PRDD to empower young talent in the area. Through

workshops with local kids, Ilori is helping them create art that's displayed across London, bringing their work into the spotlight.

Brent Youth Forum



Brent Council's Inclusion Team have set up a Youth Forum to support Brent's Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND) strategy Plan for 2021-2025.

This new forum will give young people in Brent, aged 14-25 with SEND, a real chance to influence the projects and services that matter to them.

The Youth Forum will work towards key goals:

- Give young people a voice in decisions about the services they rely on
- Help young people with SEND access the skills and support they need for adulthood
- Encourage independence, friendship-building, and pathways to employment

The forum is open to young people with SEND, whether they have an education health and care plan (EHCP) or are in the NEET group (Not in Education, Employment, or Training). It is a great chance for young people to get involved, share their ideas, and make a difference in Brent!
