

London Made Me - celebrating local talent



The Mayor of London's London Made Me Programme is part of the Creative Enterprise Zone initiative (CEZ). This programme helps artists and creatives within CEZ's to launch and run their own retail business. The project is delivered in partnership with Crafty Fox Market and Lone Design Club, with support from Battersea Power Station, Alice Mayor, Grow London Local and Visit London.

As part of the London Made Me 2024 programme, Park Royal's own Hanaa Bawamia, founder of <u>La Plante Carnivore</u>, was selected for the 2024 Retail Development Programme!

Hanaa designs sweet and colourful stationery, inspired by England's and Mauritius' flora as well as meaningful anecdotes from family and friends. The products are designed and produced locally in Park Royal while Hanaa ensures that the paper products are recyclable, FSC certified, chlorine-free, wood-free and uses compostable packaging, when necessary.

Hanaa's delightful, hand-illustrated stationery is now on display at the London Made Pop-Up Shop at Battersea Power Station.
