- <u>24/0176/FULOPDC</u>: 1 Lakeside Drive, NW10 change of use of the existing office building to a hotel and self-storage facility.
- 23/0051/FUMOPDC: Holiday Inn Express, Victoria Road, North Acton redevelopment of student accommodation of 699 bed spaces; 91 homes; ground floor commercial / retail space fronting North Acton Station Square and Victoria Road; and associated amenity space, public realm and landscaping.
- <u>23/0235/FUMOPDC</u>: 93-97a Scrubs Lane, new development of 63 homes and 129 sqm of ground floor commercial uses (Class E).
- 24/0103/FUMOPDC: 17 Western Road, Park Royal redevelopment of the site
 with a single building for general industrial use, storage and distribution and
 communal offices, together with associated parking, external operational areas
 and landscaping.
- <u>25/0011/FUMOPDC</u>: Woodward Block A, 1 Victoria Road, London W3 6AR redevelopment to provide a 14-storey building comprising purpose built student accommodation with flexible commercial and community space at ground floor.
