

## **Terms and conditions:**

1. Entry is open to UK residents aged 18 or over only, excluding employees of the Greater London Authority (GLA), Transport for London, London Legacy Development Corporation, the Mayor's Office for Policing and Crime, the London Fire and Emergency Planning Authority or any of their subsidiaries advisers, agents and/or anyone connected with the organisation of this promotion.
