

GLA Free Courses for Jobs (FCFJ) additional construction skills allocation for academic year 2025-26

Following the DfE announcement of additional funding for Free Courses for Jobs (FCFJ) in construction skills, an Expression of Interest (EOI) process was launched where London based providers who had at least £50,000 of adult skills construction delivery in London in the previous academic year (2023-24) were invited to submit an EOI for additional construction skills delivery in academic year 2025-26.

The below tables provide information on the number of providers who submitted EOI applications, funding values and expected positive outcomes.
