
Welcome to St Patrick's Festival - Parade. In this document you will find useful information about the event, including date, time, location, and what will happen on the day.

Route: The parade will makes its way from

Hyde Park through **Piccadilly, Piccadilly Circus, Regent Street St James's, and Cockspur Street**, before passing **Trafalgar Square** and finishing at **Whitehall**



Restricted areas: Do not go to **Charles Island** and **Whitehall**. These areas have limited or no public access for viewing.



Who is it for? Everyone is welcome at our event, whether you are young or old, coming with family and friends, or joining us on your own.




Accessible spectator area
