The Mayor of London's annual Eid on the Square event takes place at Trafalgar Square in Central London on **Saturday 30 May 2026**, from **12:00 PM to 6:00 PM**.

There is no need to book a ticket, and entrance is free.

The event is a celebration of Eid al-Adha meaning "Festival of Sacrifice." It is a Muslim holiday that celebrates kindness and helping others, centred around remembering the story of Prophet Ibrahim's sacrifice.

This event is open and accessible to all, aiming to bring Londoners together with this celebration of faith and sharing.

- A **main stage** programme featuring a welcome prayer, music, dance, and entertainment.
- **Activities for families and young people.**
- **A meet and greet with Omar and Hana** - perfect for a selfie.
- A **variety of stalls** and a **food market** with delicious treats!
