Thank you for your request for information which the Greater London Authority (GLA) received on 12 October 2020. Your request has been dealt with under the Freedom of Information Act 2000

You asked for:

*Please reply with a list of all of the residential development sites in Greater London that were involved in the London-Wide Initiative (LWI) scheme for affordable housing for Londoners.*

*Please state, for each site, how many homes (if any) were sold under the LWI scheme. For reference, Adelaide Wharf in Hackney, completed in November 2007, was one such development site, and may have been the first. According to MQT reference 2010/1618 (Mike Tuffey), there were 16 sites in total, but the scheme had already ended by the date the question was asked in May 2010.*
