
I have previously met with your ██████████ ██████████ and have discussed with him his concerns about the delays and difficulties you and your family have had engaging with the Metropolitan Police since the Panel was established. This was powerfully detailed within the Panel's comprehensive report, published on 15 June 2021. I raised my concerns at the time with the lead AC Nick Ephgrave and whilst some explanation was forthcoming, as the Panel has demonstrated there is still more to do.

It is my role, in support of the Mayor and working closely with the Home Secretary, to hold the Metropolitan Police Service to account to deliver the findings and recommendations from the report and drive improvements in policing in London.

I want to make the offer for you and your family to be updated on that work as it progresses. I would like to hear from you, the real change that you want to see in the way the Metropolitan Police serves Londoners today and in the future. I have also made a similar offer to your ██████████, and would be happy to meet you both, either together or separately.
