Dear Mr Khan,

I am writing in relation to a tweet you sent at 7.01am on 12 June 2020. You suggested an unsafe presence of 'extreme far right groups' in London, leading to a decision that vital BLM protests should be suspended due to a risk of disorder.

I hereby request, under the Freedom of Information Act, that your office supply me with any reports, information and file notes relating to the decision being made or any other relevant materials to substantiate your claim that there is a high risk of disorder.

Our response to your request is below:

The GLA did not locate any information as requested within the scope of your request.

The threat and or risk of disorder was evident from videos and other material that was being openly shared on social media at the time.
