Thank you for your request for information which the GLA received on 30/11/2020. Your request has been dealt with under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

You asked for;

The amount of vehicles that have been driven in your borough per day/week/month by vehicle type (lorry, car) from January 2017 until November 2020

Measures of air pollution data in your borough per day/week/month by pollution type (CO₂, O₃ (Ozone), particulate matter, NO₂) from January 2017 until November 2020

Our response to your request is as follows:

We do not hold the information for your first request. TfL may hold the information you are seeking on this matter.

Regarding your second request we hold the following information:

The report Air Quality in London 2016-2020, assesses the improvements in London's air quality between 2016 and 2020 using data from London's air quality monitoring network and modelling from Kings College London. The LAEI 2016 is the latest version of the London Atmospheric Emissions Inventory. Emissions estimates of key pollutants (NO_x, PM₁₀, PM_{2.5} and CO₂) by source type are included for the base year 2016. The area covered by the LAEI includes Greater London (the 32 London boroughs and the City of London), as well as areas outside Greater London up to the M25 motorway.
