Thank you for your request for information which the Greater London Authority (GLA) received on 9 June 2020. Your request has been dealt with under the Freedom of Information Act 2000

You asked for:

- a) the full terms and conditions of any lending/ borrowing/ grant request made by TfL/ Mayor proposed to the Government by TfL/ Mayor*
- (b) the full terms and conditions of any lending/ borrowing/ grant made by the Government to TfL/Mayor*
- (c) the level of engagement of the Mayor in those negotiations*
- (d) the level at which the final agreement was agreed and signed off by central Government; and*
- (e) the areas of difference between the request made and the agreement reached.*

Our response to your request is as follows:

- a) The GLA does not hold this information. TfL is the Mayor's transport authority and is responsible for implementing the Mayor's Transport Strategy, and for the day-to-day operational running of transport services.
