Thank you for your request for information which the GLA received on 11 June 2018. Your request has been dealt with under the Environmental Information Regulations (EIR) 2004.

You asked for disclosure of copy correspondence between the GLA and the Council between 3 April 2018 and 4 May 2018.

Please find attached the information you have requested. Please note that some of the information within scope of your request is exempt from disclosure under Regulation 13 (Personal information). Personal information relating to the names and contact information of GLA staff and members of the public constitutes as personal data which is defined by Article 4(1) of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) to mean any information relating to an identified or identifiable living individual.

It is considered that disclosure of this information would contravene the first data protection principle under Article 5(1) of GDPR which states that Personal data must be processed lawfully, fairly and in a transparent manner in relation to the data subject. It is considered that none of the conditions allow the processing of the information apply in this case as the subjects have not consented to the use of their data for an alternative purpose (namely disclosure under the EIR). Please note that responses to the application from members of the public can be obtained in summary from LB Hounslow.
