Thank you for your request for information which the Greater London Authority (GLA) received on 19 October. Your request has been dealt with under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

You asked for:

“Could you please send me the terms of reference for the review into the Silvertown Tunnel undertaken by the Mayor after his election in May.”

In requesting that TfL review the merits of the Silvertown Tunnel scheme, the Mayor asked that particular consideration be paid to the following:

- a clear commitment to delivering much-needed cross river public transport links;
- environmental assurances, both in terms of how it is constructed and once operational; and
- benefits for pedestrians and cyclists, linking to the wider opportunities for new river crossings, such as the proposed Rotherhithe to Canary Wharf crossing
