The total cost of the Christmas card competition was £6,083.06 excl. VAT. This included the printing and delivery of the cards as well as the printing and delivery of 1,216 certificates for the winning and highly commended schools and all the children that took part. The project was delivered by existing City Hall staff so there were no additional labour costs involved.

Please note that the Mayor does not send unsolicited Christmas cards to Londoners. All cards that are sent relate to his work as the Mayor of London.

6,297 Christmas cards were sent.
