Thank you for your request for information which the GLA received on 18 November 2017. Your request has been dealt with under the Environment Information Regulations 2004 (EIR).

You asked for;

1. *Correspondence between the Mayor's office and Transport for London regarding Crossrail 2's proposed route through Tooting.*
2. *Correspondence between the Deputy Mayor Val Shawcross and Transport for London regarding Crossrail 2's proposed route through Tooting.*

Please find attached the information we have identified as being within the scope of your request. The information was shared via a covering email in the form of agenda papers for TfL's Crossrail 2 board. Please note that some of the content is exempt from disclosure under Regulation 12(4)(d) of the Environmental Information Regulations, which provides that a public authority may refuse to disclose information that relates to material which is in the course of completion, to unfinished documents or to incomplete data.

A decision is yet to be reached by the government in relation to the Crossrail 2 scheme option and until then any proposals remain subject to change.

This exception is subject to a public interest test, which requires us to assess whether the public interest in applying the exception outweighs the public interest in disclosure. In this instance, it is considered that the public interest favours the finalisation of the information, after all relevant factors can be considered, rather than the disclosure of information which does not accurately reflect any amendments that might still be made.
