Thank you for your two requests for information which the GLA received on 12 September 2017. Please accept my apologies for the delay in responding. Your request has been dealt with under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

Our response to your request is as follows:

- Please release to me any documents (including emails) relating to meetings and communications between the office of the Mayor of London, his mayoral team, and The Licensed Taxi Drivers Association / The London Cab Drivers Club
- Please release to me any recorded forms of communication (including all emails) between the Office of the Mayor of London, his Mayoral team, and any representative of the GMB union that contain the word 'Uber'. Please restrict your search to the following dates: April 1st 11th September, 2017.

Please find attached. Please note that some information is exempt from disclosure under s.40 (Personal information) of the Freedom of Information Act. This information could potentially identify specific employees and individuals and as such constitutes as personal data which is defined by s.1 (1) of the Data Protection Act 1998 to mean data which relates to a living individual who can be identified from that data.

It is considered that disclosure of this information would contravene the first data protection principle which states that "Personal data shall be processed fairly and lawfully and, in particular, shall not be processed unless -

(a) at least one of the conditions in Schedule 2 is met, and

(b) in the case of sensitive personal data, at least one of the conditions in Schedule 3 is also met."

It is considered that none of the conditions allow the processing of the information apply in this case as the subjects have not consented to the use of their data for an alternative purpose (namely disclosure under the Freedom of Information Act).
