Thank you for your request for information which the GLA received on 15 January 2018. Your request has been dealt with under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

You requested:

*1 - all correspondence between the GLA and the Scottish Government;  
2 - notes/minutes of any meetings between the GLA and the Scottish Government;  
3 - internal GLA emails or meeting notes/minutes discussing liaison with the Scottish Government,  
in each case since the election of Mayor Sadiq Khan.*

You clarified:

*The topic I am interested in is the United Kingdom's withdrawal from the European Union.*

Please find attached the information we hold within the scope of your request.

We have made some redactions to withhold names and addresses from the disclosed information as they constitute third-party personal data which is exempt from release under the provision of section 40(2) of the Fol Act. This provides that personal data (as defined under the Data Protection Act 1998) can be withheld from disclosure in to the public domain where that disclosure would be contrary to one of the Data Protection Principles under that Act. In this case, disclosure would be in breach of the first principle and constitute unfair processing of that data.
