

Thank you for your request for information which the GLA received on 6 December 2016. Your request has been dealt with under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

You asked for:

"The Development Infrastructure Funding Study for Kingston upon Thames (DIFS) or current draft thereof, together with data that gives the assumptions on which the Study is based and information that shows in full the assumptions used in the study. Please also send minutes of meetings in which the DIFS has been proposed, discussed or approved or mentioned in any way, together with the names of people participating in any such discussions or meetings or decisions".

Where possible DIF studies are produced for all opportunity areas. As such the intention to carry out a DIF study for Kingston was added to page 40 of the Direction of Travel document consulted on in the summer. However this work is not yet underway. As such there have been no meetings to discuss the DIF study and no draft document or data to send you. The GLA does not hold the information you have requested.
