Thank you for your request for information which the GLA received on 1 May 2018. Your request has been dealt with under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

You asked for;

- The definition of 'Starts on site outtrun' used by the Greater London Authority to calculate GLA Housing Starts on Site and Completions for the statistics to the end of March 2018.
- Whether the definition of 'Starts on site outtrun' used by the Greater London Authority to calculate GLA Housing Starts on Site and Completions, has changed between the 2016–17, 2017–18 and 2018–19 financial years.

The definition of start on site and completions are as published in the capital funding guide, which can be found <u>here</u> in sections 2.2.50 and 2.2.52.

The definitions have not changed since 2016. Please note that this gives the earliest point at which start or completion can be claimed. The date recorded may be later if the Registered provider does not claim the milestone on our systems until later. For example, partners waited until contracts were completed for our 16-21 programme before claiming start on site under that programme.
