Thank you for your request for information which the Greater London Authority (GLA) received on 28 January 2022. Your request has been considered under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

You requested:

Please include the information for each of the following periods; 2018-19; 2019-20; 2020-21; 2021-22:

- *The number of graffiti swastikas removed by the council for each year*
- *The cost of removing the swastikas for each year*

Our response:

The GLA does not hold information in scope of your request. For the limited areas that the GLA is responsible for, e.g. Trafalgar Square, our contractors do not log specific information regarding the details of cleaning/graffiti removal so we do not have a tally or costs relating to swastikas.

The GLA is London's strategic government and does not operate in the same way as local councils responsible for street cleaning. In London you would need to contact the Borough Councils, including the City of London and Westminster City Council:
