## Decision required – supporting report

## 1. Introduction and background

1.1. The MPS wishes to upgrade all Command and Control CAD desktops, which were originally outside of the scope of the Next Generation Desktop Windows 8.1 Deployment programme. The CAD desktops were part of the now defunct Command and Control Futures Programme. This upgrade project will support the MPS's corporate objective of achieving the implementation of Windows 8.1 across the whole estate and address operating system obsolescence within the MPS estate.

#### 2. Issues for consideration

- 2.1. The current CAD desktops are nearing the end of support life and need to be replaced/upgraded to ensure continued support and maintenance from the SIAM support providers.

- 3.1 The cost of £733,000 to upgrade the Command and Control CAD desktops to Windows 8.1 will be funded via a virement from the ANPR programme capital plan.

# **Command & Control Windows 8.1 CAD Project**

#### EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This paper seeks approval for an additional £733K capital funding to cover the cost of upgrading all Command & Control CAD desktops to Windows 8.1. The total cost for the implementation is £1250K and £517K is already approved in the capital plan. The project will address operating system obsolescence across the corporate estate and to align with the corporate objective to upgrade to Windows 8.1.

## A. RECOMMENDATIONS – That MOPAC

1. Approves the allocation and release of funding to cover the cost of upgrading all CAD desktops to Windows 8.1. This is to address operating system obsolescence across the corporate estate and to align with the corporate objective to upgrade to Windows 8.1.

## **B. SUPPORTING INFORMATION**

CAD desktops were outside the scope of the Next Generation Desktop Windows 8.1 Deployment programme due to the project being in scope of the now terminated Command and Control Futures programme. Delivery of Windows 8.1 desktops to MetCC and other CAD workstations is now the responsibility of the Command and Control Programme. The current CAD Desktops are nearing end of support life and need to be replaced/upgraded to ensure continued support and maintenance from the MPS SIAM Support providers.

#### Approach to Upgrade

- 1. The upgrading to Windows 8.1 CAD Desktops will involve all CAD desktops across the main command and Control sites, Lambeth, Hendon and Bow, as well as remote CAD desktop locations across the MPS estate and non-MPS remote CAD locations. The work will be planned and carried out with no downtime to the operational Command and Control (First Contact, Despatch and SOR etc.). As a result of the CAD desktop location analysis work that has been carried out to identify the number and physical locations of all CAD desktops across the corporate estate, the following deployment approach is an outline of the expected upgrade approach.
- 2. Another factor to consider in the planning phase is that as the Command and Control function involves shift work across the three main sites this will require incorporating into the final deployment approach.

- 3. The upgrading process will include the deployment of new desktop hardware and two new monitors per workstation. These two activities will be carried out at the same time in order to minimise the user impact of the project activities.
- 4. The first sites to be upgraded will be the main Command and Control Centres (order to be agreed with the business units) and following the successful completion of this phase, remote CAD desktop sites will be upgraded on a priority basis that will be confirmed during the planning phase.
