#### Our response to your request is as follows:

The table provided below indicates the number of grants or loans provided to SMEs where the organisations are understood to be SMEs.

A further table provided indicates the individual grants or loans paid to SMEs during the period 2013/14 to 2015/16.

It should be noted that these grants or loans are not provided to businesses for the purposes of growth and innovation of that SME but to deliver interventions that may support business innovation and growth more widely.

It should also be noted that where information is available to confirm whether a grant or loan recipient is an SME, this is taken from Transport for London's (TfL) Supplier Registration information (TfL provides a procurement and payment service for the Greater London Authority and the London Enterprise Panel). This is based on data of number of employees and turnover provided by the grant/loan recipient at the point at which they register to be a supplier to receive funds. This data is then checked by TfL using Creditsafe to ensure it is correct. It should be noted that should a grant/loan recipient's status change during this period this would not be reported in this data.
