MOPAC's Non-Executive Advisers are entitled to invoice for up to 60 days work in any 12 month period at a day rate of £500. For the period October 2012 (when they were appointed) to August 2013, the following remuneration has been paid to MOPAC's non-executive advisers:

Faith Boardman: £26,500

Jeremy Mayhew: £25,562

Jonathan Glanz: £27,000

Steve O'Connell: £0.00 (he has chosen not to receive remuneration for this post).

Expenses for the period October 2012 to August 2013 were:
