- Please could the data be from when Sadig Khan started as mayor until the present day

From our preliminary assessment, it is clear that we will not be able to answer your request in full without further clarification and we need further information in order to identify and locate the specific information you have asked for. Please could you explain what information you want when you ask about "time"? It is not clear whether you are asking about the time of day or the duration of the journey.

In order to locate the cab company details, where available, we would need to carry out further searches.

Once you have clarified your request, I will be able to begin to process your request. Under section 1(3) of the Freedom of Information Act, a public authority need not comply with a request unless any further information reasonably required to locate the information is supplied.
