around £11.9
billion in 2016



London must
ensure that it can provide
suitable accommodation
that meets the needs of
all those that wish to
visit, including those with
accessibility
requirements

Comparisons
of projected supply and
demand show that London
would currently meet
demand for accessible
hotel rooms when using
the mobility impaired
definition of
accessibility





However, London
would require between
9.7% and 14.2% of all
new hotel rooms to be
accessible if it was to
meet demand using the
wider all disabled
definition of
accessibility
