Thank you for your request for information which the Greater London Authority (GLA) received on 3 July 2022. Your request has been considered under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

You requested:

For each of the 4 football games being staged in London for the Women's Euro 2022 competition, please specify:

- 1. The number of tickets allocated to the Greater London Authority.*
- 2. The number of these tickets made available to people employed in the Mayor's Office, or their guests.*
- 3. The number of these tickets made available to people employed in any GLA directorate other than the Mayor's Office, or their guests.*
- 4. The number of these tickets made available to employees of organisations other than the GLA.*

To clarify, by 'people employed' I would include the Mayor, Assembly Members, political appointees. And also to clarify, I would like these four pieces of information for each of the four games individually.

Our response is as follows:

For information - there are 5 games being staged in London for the Women's Euro 2022 competition. Please note where information relates to matches that have already taken place - it is final and correct. For future matches (16th, 21st and 31st) some of the information may be subject to change.

1. The GLA has been allocated 130 tickets from the FA across the five matches in London across the tournament. The GLA has purchased an additional 70 General Admission (GA) tickets for these matches . See below for breakdown:
