Thank you for your request for information which the GLA received on 22 September 2017. Your request has been dealt with under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

You asked for the following information;

- i. *the details of all meetings with the licensed taxi drivers association over the past 12 months*
- ii. *the details of all meetings at which the interests of the licensed taxi drivers association were discussed*

The Mayor and his team (including Val Shawcross) have not had any meetings with the LTDA.

- iii. *the specific evidence (documents, studies, statistics etc), in each case making clear the source of the data, that has led to the reversal of the acceptance of Uber drivers as safe.*

The GLA does not hold this information. Transport for London (TfL) is the Mayor's transport authority and is responsible for implementing the Mayor's Transport Strategy, and for the day-to-day operational running of transport services.
