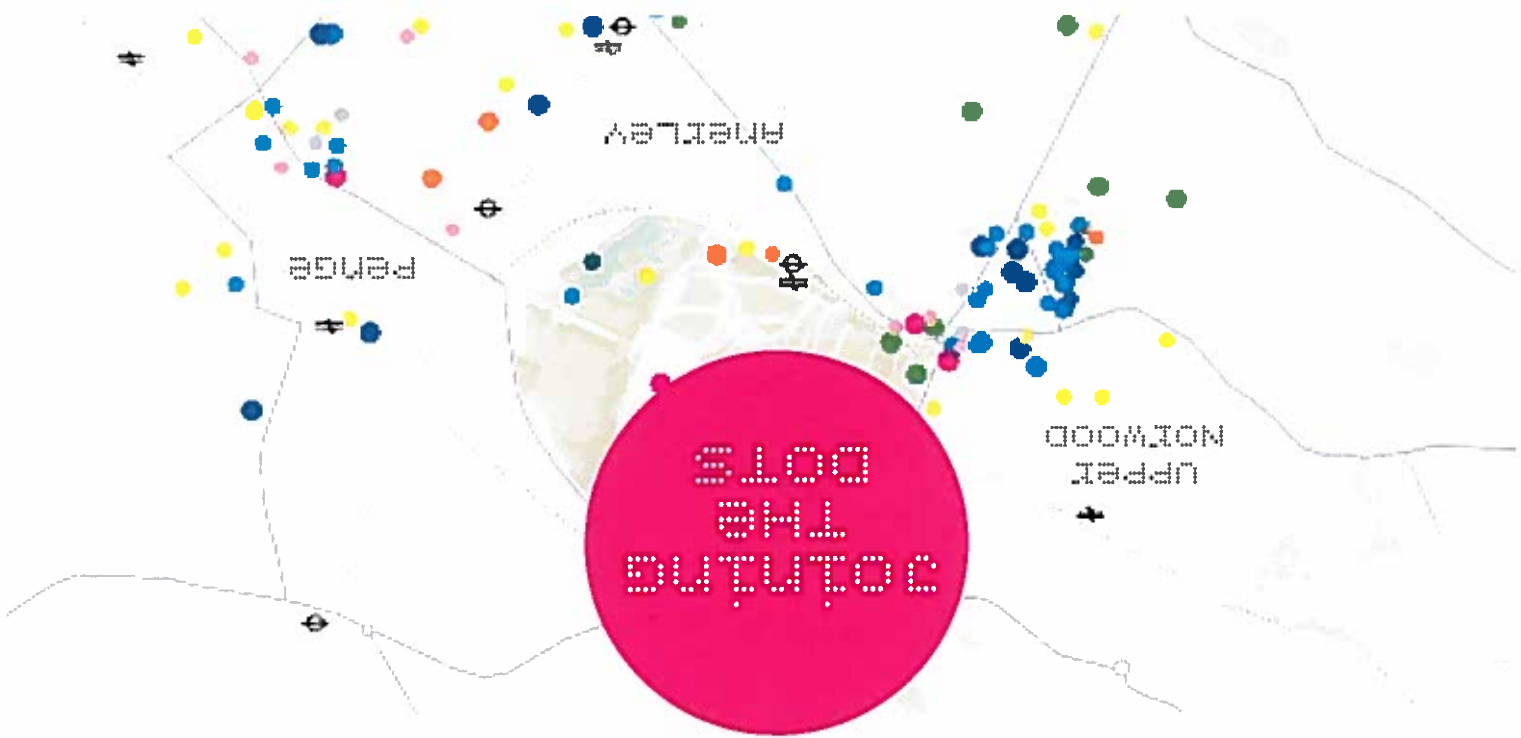




Dissemination strategy for the study
