1. Please may I request the amount spent to date on the 'London is Open' campaign and any amounts forecast to be spent in the future on the same.

The LondonIsOpen campaign costs incurred to date are listed below.

Merchandise for Mayor of London events and activities - £10,608.33
Print costs for TfL advertising - £14,062
Social media advertising - £3,534.96
Photography - £1,700
Video production - £6,783
Branding and signage - £1,717
Travel expenses - £500
Event infrastructure and security - £5,054
Audience awareness research - £2,920

The total cost of the campaign to date is £46,879.35.

A total budget of up to £150,000 has been allocated to the LondonIsOpen campaign. The marketing and events campaign budget details can be found via the web address below.
