I have been advised that no papers relating to undercover policing have been to a meeting of the Audit Panel. I can also confirm that we do not hold any other documents that would fall within the scope of your request.

I understand that there was mention of the upcoming publication of the HMIC report in a March 2012 restricted report. However this mention of an upcoming publication does not meet within the scope of your request.
